

## **Important Notice Before First Use!**


Thank you for choosing our window cleaning robot!

To ensure your new device works optimally, please follow these steps for proper setup and first-time use.

---

### **First Setup: Prime the Spray System**

1. **Fill both water tanks completely with clean water**  
Please use only clean water (ideally distilled water).



2. **Manually activate the spray nozzles several times**

Hold the robot in your hand and press the manual spray button ("☉") repeatedly until water is visibly sprayed from all nozzles.

Pressing the button multiple times is sufficient – but sometimes the system may need a bit longer to flush out all the air.

 **Why is this important?** Air may enter the system during shipping. The spray performance becomes more stable over time as any remaining air is released.

 **Tip:** Perform this step over a sink or similar area where water spray is not an issue.

## Notes on the Spray Function

- The robot sprays in N-mode only while moving downward – this is intentional to prevent self-spraying.
- Start by using clear or distilled water. Optionally, a highly diluted glass cleaner solution in a ratio of 1:10 (cleaning solution to water) can be added later.
-  **Do not use any concentrates**, thick or foaming glass cleaners, or hard water with high lime content! These can clog the nozzles and cause streaks.

## Common Questions & Quick Solutions

- **Device won't turn off, shows red light:** Some moisture may have entered the device. Let it dry completely in a sunny, dry place.
- **Robot slips down:** Check the cleaning pads (they might be too wet) and clean the drive wheel tracks (connect the device without turning it on, then press the upward button).
- **Low spray output:** Press the spray button ("") multiple times or flush the system longer off the window.
- **Blocked nozzle:** Carefully insert a fine needle into the nozzle to clear it – no deeper than 1 mm.
- **Streaks on the glass:** Use fresh cleaning pads and clean or distilled water. Clean the drive wheel tracks (see above) and ensure the spray function is working correctly.
